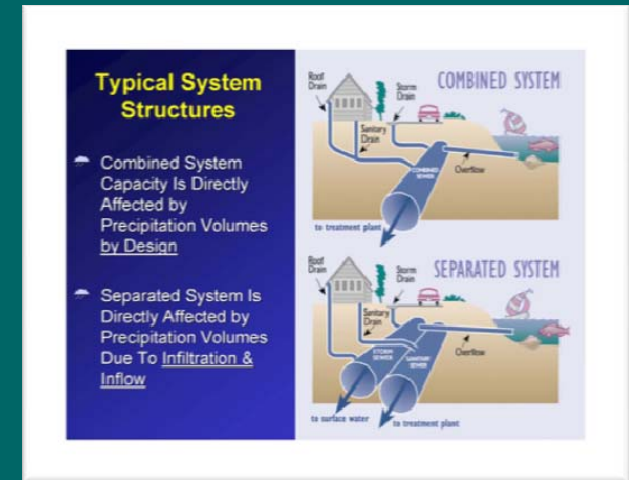


CSO Abatement Program (20-Year, \$200 Million Combined Sewer Overflow) Unified Government of Wyandotte County / Kansas City, Kansas



The Unified Government of Wyandotte County / Kansas City, Kansas implemented a 20-year, \$200 Million Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) Abatement Program in response to the Federal CSO Control Policy established in 1997. **DRG's** role was the overall management of the program. **DRG has provided studies and design and construction phase services for a number of CSO elimination projects since that time.**

This large program involved the elimination of 80+ combined sewer overflows (CSOs) located in the city. **DRG** developed the Nine Minimum Controls Manual as well as the Long Term Control Plan (LTCP) used to address CSOs. Design and construction work was conducted at the Kaw Point WWTP to maximize its treatment capacity. Improvements to two major pump stations have also been completed. Several storm sewer separation projects have been constructed, which has addressed 31 CSOs to date.



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
