

Turkey Creek Interceptor Sewer

Unified Government of Wyandotte County / Kansas City, Kansas



This UG project involved the installation of 5,500 LF of 48-inch DIP sanitary sewer to replace a segment of existing sewer that was abandoned to facilitate the reconstruction of Interstate 35 between Mission Road and 7th Street Trafficway.

The sewer location had to be coordinated with both the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) and the Corps of Engineers which was realigning the Turkey Creek channel in conjunction with the highway reconstruction project. The project also included the installation of 17 new manholes, two connections to the existing interceptor sewer, 270 LF of tunnel construction, and filling of the abandoned 30-inch sewer with flowable fill.
